PIECES TO PATHWAYS

P2P offers a full range of substance use support services, including the provision of 3 community drop-in spaces, individual addictions counselling and case management, and structured groups for LGBTQIA2S+ youth ages 16-29. All services are delivered by LGBTQIA2S+ staff members with their own experiences of substance use and recovery.

HARM REDUCTION OUTREACH

The Harm Reduction Outreach team works with people who use drugs and who can not afford to pay for services. We provide counselling and case management services. Our program will meet with anyone in Toronto who fits our criteria who would like support addressing their substance use, and/or who would like access to safer use supplies.

PROGRAM INFORMATION

SATELLITE OPIOID TREATMENT CLINIC

Satellite is a community-based outpatient opioid addiction treatment service. Services include opioid agonist treatment counselling, and case management, among others.

ADDICTION SUPPORTIVE HOUSING

The Supportive Housing program is offered in partnership with Regeneration Community Services, and is available to individuals who are currently housed in our program only, are 16+, who have problematic substance use and require stable housing. The program provides supportive housing to people without requirements for engaging in addiction treatment. Participants are referred to us through Regeneration.

FAMILY AND YOUTH INITIATIVES

This initiative is an outpatient program developed to meet the needs of youth, aged 12 to 25, and their family members and friends who are struggling with substance use concerns. We provide individual and family therapy, school outreach, and harm reduction education.

TORONTO OPIOID SUPPORT TEAM

The Toronto Opioid Support Team provides outreach services for people who are using opiates and replacement medications, and have little or no access to supportive services. We work collaboratively with agencies and programs in the community to offer holistic, compassionate, accessible and flexible ongoing or short term support.
